

## GECO Code of Conduct

We are guests of the church who permit us to hold classes for this co-op. This is a house of God. Behave accordingly. Remember that GECO is a privilege and not a right. With all privileges come responsibilities. You will behave in a responsible and respectful manner at all times during GECO hours.

Students may not write on or any way deface furniture, walls, bulletin boards, or any property that does not belong to them. If a student destroys any church property, the student and his/her family will be responsible for having the property repaired or replaced, at the church's discretion.

Lunch will be eaten in the designated area or outside under adult supervision. These areas must be left clean after the lunch period.

Food and soft drinks are not allowed in the hallways or classrooms AT ANY TIME, unless approved by the teacher. Water is allowed in the classes and hallways at any time.

The playground equipment is only for elementary children and younger, all children must be accompanied by an adult when using this area. Younger children have priority in this area.

GECO students will be permitted in designated areas as determined by the Board and the church. Adult supervision will be required. Students are not permitted to gather or loiter in the parking area at any time, nor allowed to leave church property without the permission of the parent.

The host church is a non-smoking, drug free, alcohol free, and gun free facility. Any students caught in possession of these items will be asked to leave and not allowed to return. Parents, if you must smoke, you must leave the church property.

### Dress Code:

GECO participant's dress should be modest and appropriate at all times. This includes students and adults.

- No spaghetti straps, low cut tops, tank tops, or bare midriffs – this means no hip, tummy skin, or cleavage visible at any time.
- No sheer material.
- No tight shirts or excessively tight shorts or pants.
- Skirts and shorts must be no shorter than fingertip length.
- No hats of any form in the building unless GECO is hosting a special "Hat Day" event.
- No statement on any clothing that is vulgar, rude, or appears to dishonor God or the Christian faith.
